AGM April 12th 2015

Twenty five people attended the recent AGM of Northants Branch MND Association.

The chair welcomed members and quests and apologies were received. Minutes of the previous AGM were discussed, agreed and signed.

The chair reported on a busy and profitable year with many events throughout the year April 2014 --- April 2015. Our usual fundraisers again supporting us with golf days, a quiz night, music evenings, a concert, bake-it days and coffee mornings. We attended a couple of Medical Matters Awareness Days and attended the Association AGM and Conference in September.

Highlights of the year were the film of Stephen Hawking and his first wife Jane, their love and the battle with MND, Professor Hawking is a Patron of the Association. We had collections at two cinemas whilst the film was being shown, raising £444.19 for the branch. A charity "Walk for a Cause" presented the branch with a cheque £1,000 The Ice Bucket Challenge went global raising over £7 million for the Association and over \$100 million in U.S.A. Our Charter Campaign finished at midnight May 6th, all collected names will be presented at Downing Street in the hope to get better services for people with MND.
