The Coalition Campaign United to End MND has secured £50 million over the next 5 years from the UK Government targeted to research into MND. The Government is committed to investing £375 million into research into neurodegenerative diseases.

Congratulations to all involved with this campaign and tremendous achievement.

Scrap 6 months

The MND Association and Marie Curie have over the past 3 years been campaigning for the Special Rules for Terminal Illness SRTI to be scrapped from 6 months to 12 months. This has been achieved through the hard work of staff, celebrities, clinicians, councilors and politicians. The rules are now expanded to 12 months, which will mean that more people living with MND will be able to access the support so badly needed more quickly and easily.
